Subject: Completion of Selection Process, Ranking of Firms and Contract Negotiations for On-Call Professional Construction Support Services

It is my pleasure to inform the Board of Airport Commissioners (BOAC) that Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) has completed the selection process, ranked the firms, and negotiated the terms for six On-Call Professional Construction Support Services contracts to provide construction support services for various Airports and Capital Improvement Projects at Los Angeles International Airport (LAX), LA/Ontario International Airport (ONT), and Van Nuys Airport (VNY).

There will be three large valued contracts (\$25m) and three small valued contracts (\$5m) awarded to provide services for three separate elements:

- 1) Airside
- 2) Terminals
- 3) Other Airport Support Facilities and Infrastructure
