New Escort Icon Required

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Pursuant to recent security directives issued by the Transportation Security Administration (TSA), airports must reduce to an operational minimum the number of persons who are authorized to escort other persons into restricted/secured or sterile areas. In addition, each person authorized to escort must receive training on their responsibilities for escorting as well as be readily identifiable as having authority to escort. To meet these requirements:

- ✓ The Security Badge Office has created a new icon to denote that a badge holder has authority to provide escorts in the area to which their badge allows them access
- ✓ An Escort Training Program has been developed for employees so designated

Training Classes will begin December 11, 2006. A schedule will be forwarded to all authorized signers.

Classes will generally be held at the Security Badge Office, in Training Room "B" on a regular schedule. However, if a company has a significant amount of employees that require the training (25 +), arrangements can be made to schedule specific classes for those employees.

Effective February 1, 2007, only those persons who have met all of the above requirements and have received the Escort Icon on their badge will be authorized to conduct escorts.
