EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

EMPLOYEES MAY NOT BRING LIQUIDS, GELS, OR AEROSOLS OF ANY SIZE INTO THE STERILE AREA

Including beverages, shampoo, suntan lotion, creams, toothpaste, hair gel, hair spray, and other items of similar consistency

Employees may bring the following into the sterile area:

- ▶ Prescription medicine (liquid and gel) with a name that matches the employee's ID
- ▶ Essential other non-prescription medicines not to exceed 4 oz. (120ml) per container, to include saline solution and eye care products such as eye drops and contact lens solution
- ▶ Liquids (to include juice) or gels for diabetic employees who indicate a need for such items to address their medical condition. Quantities are limited to no greater than 5 oz. (148ml) per container.
- ▶ Solid cosmetics and personal hygiene items such as lipstick in a tube, solid deodorant, lip balm, and similar solids.

**EMPLOYEES ENTERING THE STERILE AREA
ARE SUBJECT TO INSPECTION**

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

PASSENGERS MAY NOT HAVE LIQUIDS, GELS, OR AEROSOLS OF ANY SIZE AT THE SCREENING CHECKPOINT OR IN THE CABIN OF THE AIRCRAFT

Including beverages, shampoo, suntan lotion, creams, toothpaste,
hair gel, hair spray, liquid cosmetics, and other items of similar consistency
Such items may be transported in checked baggage

Passengers may have:

- ▶ Baby formula/milk and baby food in small containers if a baby or small child is traveling
- ▶ Prescription medicine (liquid and gel) with a name that matches the passenger's ID
- ▶ Essential other non-prescription medicines not to exceed 4 oz. (120ml) per container, to include saline solution and eye care products such as eye drops and contact lens solution
- ▶ Liquids (to include juice) or gels for diabetic passengers who indicate a need for such items to address their medical condition. Quantities are limited to no greater than 5 oz. (148ml) per container.
- ▶ Solid cosmetics and personal hygiene items such as lipstick in a tube, solid deodorant, lip balm, and similar solids

Beverages purchased in the sterile area must be consumed before
boarding the aircraft.
